CREMPA is an umbrella body of dairy farmers in Malawi's central region. The association was established in 1985 but registered in 2005 as a Trustee (RG20754/IM/5.2005) under the Trustee Incorporation Act. CREMPA has a membership of 11,120 farmers organized in 66 Milk Bulking Groups (MBGs) in all the nine districts of the central region of Malawi. CREMPA envisions to be Malawi's leading farmer organization in promoting economic empowerment and sustainable livelihood with a powerful collective voice to champion the interest of dairy farmers. Its mission is to organise and empower dairy farmers in central region to create a conducive environment for sustainable improved milk productivity and marketing and increased farmers income and livelihood security. CREMPA work is centred on; capacity building and input supply, business development, advocacy and lobbying, and market linkages.

CREMPA is implementing the "Economic Empowerment and financial Inclusion of Women and Youth through Dairy Agribusiness" project with financial assistance of Swedish International Development Agency (Sida) and We Effect in Dowa and Mchinji districts. The project aims to address the economic underrepresentation and financial exclusion of women and youth in dairy development programs.
