



PROCUREMENT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE BY TENDER

CADECOM has presence in all the 28 districts of Malawi through its 8 diocesan offices in six strategic areas of; food security and nutrition, relief and rehabilitation, Water, hygiene and sanitation, Climate Change adaptation and mitigation, Disaster Risk Reduction, lobbying and advocacy, Training for Transformation and crosscutting issues (gender and HIV/AIDS, disability, and human rights). Although CADECOM is an arm of the Catholic Church in Malawi, it does not discriminate and works with people of all religious affiliation. Our work and targeting procedure is determined by levels of vulnerability.
