1. Background

The Government of Malawi, through the Ministry of Health (MoH) is implementing the **Presidential Initiative on Maternal Health** project to address key maternal health challenges in the country through a health systems approach. This will address the root causes of the high and rising Maternal morbidity and mortality in the country. It will also impact on related indicators including: (i) maternal mortality ratio (ii) Neonatal Mortality Rate (iii) Adolescent fertility rate and (iv) Number of new users of modern contraceptive methods among women aged 15-49 among others.

The Ministry of Health therefore seeks to engage qualified individual consultants and or consulting firms to undertake several consultancies under the project through a professional, participatory and evidence-based consultancy services. The consultancy assignments are as follows;
